Strap



Cradle





Clip the strap into the inside of the hat in the locations illustrated.

Clip the cradle into the 4 remaining slots illustrated, ensuring the headband is positioned at the front of the hat.



Adjust to fit using the pin lock system in the rear of the cradle.



Ensure all clips are firmly pushed into place before use.
